## **Formal requirements**

The language of the thesis is English.

Length is appropriate (30-60 pages without Cover Page, Table of Contents, List of Abbreviations, Student Profile, References,

Bibliography, and Acknowledgements).

A4 page.

1.5 Line Spacing, justified text

Times New Roman font.

Font size 12 throughout the paper.

Margins are 3 cm throughout the whole document.

The structure follows the CTM requirement (see <u>Thesis Template</u> <u>– Table of</u> <u>Contents</u>)

Each chapter is numbered.

All numbered main/sub-chapters are included in the table of contents. All main chapters start on a new page.

The cover page of the dissertation is prepared according to the sample (see <u>**Thesis**</u> <u>**Template – Cover Page**</u>)

The thesis booklet is prepared according to the sample <u>(**Thesis**</u> <u>**Template – Thesis**</u> <u>**Booklet**</u>)

The cover page includes everyone's position and highest degree.

Page numbering is centered at the bottom.

The number of publications complies with the requirements of the Doctoral Regulations.

The Impact Factor/Score of publications meets the requirements of the field.

Publications are attached as Appendices.

Figures and tables are appropriately labeled and explained. Figure legends are below the figures, table legends are above the tables.

References are formatted according to the Doctoral Regulations (Vancouver/NLM (<u>http://www.biomedicaleditor.com/vancouver-style.html</u>) or APA 7th edition (<u>https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammar-guidelines</u>)
